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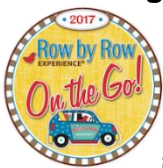

FRENCH BRAID WITH PANEL

Class Fee: \$50

Learn the French Braid technique to provide a striking border for a printed panel. This class will teach you the basics of French Braid which can then be used as borders on any quilt or to create entire quilts from French Braid strips. Fabric selection is an important step. Our French Braid will use between nine

and thirteen different fabrics. While this pattern appears complicated, the sewing is not difficult and you can achieve beautiful results with good fabric selection, careful cutting and precise piecing.

Session 1: Fabric selection, cutting & beginning the first braid.

Session 2: Finishing the braids and attaching them to the panel to complete the quilt top.
